PE	Teaching Games for Understanding: Introduction to basic game concepts, simple strategies, and skill development of a wide variety of games.  Invasion Games: Introduction to the basic skills and strategies of invasion games, with an emphasis on teamwork, movement, and fundamental game awareness. Developing a foundation for more complex game play and tactical understanding.	Dance: Students will be given a routine as a project for the topic. The routine will allow for students to create dance moves which fit in with the style of music.  Striking and Fielding Games: Students will develop their ability to strike a moving ball.
